Sub: Deputation of Ayurveda Practitioner to Malaysia –reg

Sir,

As part of implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between Government of India and Malaysia on cooperation in the field of Traditional Medicine, Government of Malaysia has requested Ministry of AYUSH to depute one Ayurveda Practitioner in replacement of the existing incumbent to Malaysia initially for a period of one year.

2. The Government of Malaysia had started 'Shirodhara' and 'External Basti Therapy' in the Traditional and Complementary Medicine Unit at Port Dickson Hospital and Cheras Rehabilitation Hospital, Government Hospitals under Ministry of Health, Malaysia. The tenure of the Ayurveda Practitioner deputed under ITEC programme of Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) will be completed on 17.05.19. Considering the popularity gained by the Ayurvedic treatments among the public, the Government of Malaysia has requested for deputing another Ayurveda Practitioner at the earliest to ensure the continuity of Ayurveda treatment at these hospitals.

3. A copy of the ITEC application form received from MEA with the details of the project, duties of expert, eligibility criteria etc is enclosed herewith. The appointment on deputation will be made under the ITEC programme of MEA. The ITEC expert would be paid Basic Pay, the Foreign Compensatory Allowance and other admissible allowances depending upon his rank fixed by the MEA. Accommodation, local transport and medical facilities will be provided by the receiving Government as per the rank of the expert.

4. You are requested to circulate this letter to all Government Ayurvedic/Siddha Institutions in your state to give wide publicity to the post to be filled by deputation initially for one year so that suitable and willing officers, capable of providing effective service in Malaysia can apply.
